Sources for the Study of the English Civil War (1642 - 1651)

The King's standard erected at Nottingham (starting the English Civil War) Oct 1642 Parliamentarians (commanded by Sir John Gell of Derbyshire) seize control of Sheffield Castle on 11 October 1642 The Battle of Edgehill on 23 October 1642 (the first major conflict of the Civil War between Royalist and Parliamentarian forces) ends in stalemate
